"...greater works than these..." John 5:20; 14:12

A Bible student will find this particular phrase but twice in all of Scripture where both places it is spoken by our LORD JESUS. In the earlier passage penned of John, JESUS has just healed a cripple ... in the latter passage HE is in the upper room giving HIS disciples some final instructions on the eve of HIS crucifixion. In the first instance JESUS is going about ministry to the "marvel" of HIS naysayers; in the last instance HE is handing the fire of this ministry to those who would be commissioned to carry that torch of salvation to a world dark in sin.
